8. Vice President - Amanda Eicher

- 8.1. Please bear in mind that the City meet could be very different next year, as this year's meet was rained out after the first race. 4 other races were canceled. Fortunately, Coach Rafferty and the officials were able to take most of the extra food from us, most of it at cost. I feel that this meet would have been much busier if it hadn't been rained out. However, the Sectional meet was not as busy as it seems like it would be. Fortunately, I started to realize that the week before the meet occurred and adjusted my purchases to account for how fast that meet runs, so we sold most of the items we had. I had about 20 Chik Fil A sandwiches left over, so I took them to the football concession stand, since their playoff game was due to start.

9. 2nd Vice-President – Laura Campbell

- 9.1. **Report** – Eagle Scout needs approval from his troop leader regarding the indoor concession stand remodel. The work should take one week after approval. Ducks are being ordered but we need to decide how much we're charging, which games we'll be doing the duck game at, what the give-aways will be, how many will be offered. Laura's developed a poster to advertise the event. Supreme Courts offered to let us do a 3 x 3 basketball (or dodgeball) tournament at their facility in March with all proceeds going directly to Boosters. Potential to earn good profits. Laura is meeting with Heather in December to discuss the details and will present it at the December Booster meeting.

- 10.1. **Report** -Needs to finalize the 5k run numbers with the PTA. There are some deposits they have made to their account directly and some final accounting of the expenses. I would expect that to be completed by end of November and funds split. Next year we need to discuss the returns and paying a fee (\$80) to automate the process. Financials are compiled as of 11-14-13.
